## **Exodus**

Review

Overview: "Going forth." Written by Moses during wilderness wanderings. Knew all the details of Egypt and history of Egyptians.

Population of the Hebrews increase significantly. Good conditions.

400 years after end of Genesis.

New Pharaoh. New dynasty began.

Covenants

The Law.

**Ex 1**: descendants from Jacob's sons. Population increases. Promises to Abraham.

8: a new king who did not remember Joseph.

9: Look how many Hebrews there are! Soon there will be more of them than us.

Hebrews are enslaved to work in mortar and brick. Taskmasters over them. Continue to increase in population. Build cities and pyramids. Hard labor.

Order to Hebrew midwives. Kill the baby boys; let the girls live. Deceive Pharaoh. Moral law. The he orders Hebrew boys thrown into the River.

Moses parents- Amram and Jochebed- tribe of Levi.

Basket, (ark) made of bulrushes, pitch, into the River. Miriam follows it along. Moses parents mentioned in Book of Hebrews "hall of fame."

Pharaoh's daughter. Hires Hebrew woman to nurse him. Moses' mother! Stays with his family for several years. Education of the Hebrews. Knows Yahweh.

Pharaoh's daughter names him Moses, drawn from the water.

Moses grows up; has official position; by **faith** (Book of Hebrews) goes to see his people.

Murders the Egyptian. Witnessed. Then distressed by fight between 2 Hebrews.

Decree of death from Pharaoh.

Flees to Midian. Cares for flocks of Jethro (Reuel) and marries his daughter Zipporah. Has a son named Gershom.

I am a stranger in a strange land.

Moses' life 40-40-40

God's plan for His people. Now time to deliver from Egypt.

Cry of the people went up to God. God heard the cries of His people and "remembered" the Covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.
